The King is Coming Selected Scriptures

I. God's Promise of a S_____ (Gen. 3:15):

- a. God is the Creator—Gen. 1:1; Ex. 31:15-17; Isa. 4:5-7; Col. 1:16; Heb. 11:3
- b. Satan's threefold temptation is throughout Scripture—Gen. 3:6; Matt. 4:3-9; 1 John 2:16; James 3:15
- c. Jesus is the promised Seed, born of a daughter of Eve, fully God and fully man!
- d. Only the shedding of blood can atone for sins—Gen. 1:21; Lev. 17:11; John 19:30; 2 Cor. 5:21; Heb. 9:22

II. Isaac's S_____ in the Thicket (Gen. 22:9-14):

- a. God Tests—Gen. 22:1; Deut. 8:2; Ps. 26:2; 139:23; Jer. 17:10
- b. **to the place of which God had told him** = Mount Moriah—2 Sam. 24:18, 21; 1 Kings 6:5-6
- c. Jesus is our Substitutional Atonement—Isa. 53:4-6; John 1:29; 2 Cor. 5:21

III. Moses' Passover L_____ (Ex. 12:3-13):

- a. **the tenth day of this month** (Nisan) = the day Jesus entered Jerusalem
- b. **Your lamb shall be an unblemished male** = the sinless King Jesus
- c. **the fourteenth day of the same month** (Nisan) = the actual day that Jesus was crucified
- d. **the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses** = the atoning blood of Jesus...which was shed **at twilight**—Deut. 16:6; 1 Cor. 5:7; Luke 23:44-46

IV. Isaiah's Suffering S_____ (Isa. 53:4-5, 10):

- a. **He was pierced through** His hands and feet when He was nailed to Calvary's Cross
- b. It is **by His scourging** that our souls are ultimately healed
- c. He made Himself our **guilt offering** so our sins could be atoned for—Lev. 5:14-19; 7:1-7; 14:12-18; 1 Peter 2:24

V. Jeremiah's Righteous B_____ (Jer. 23:5-6):

- a. This is the type of **king** the Jews were looking for in Jesus' first coming, a conqueror in the royal line of David—Ps. 118:26

VI. The Angel Gabriel's Messiah P_____ (Dan. 9:24-26):

- a. **weeks** = weeks of years (7 years)

- b. **Seventy weeks** = God's plan for Israel
- c. **seven weeks and sixty-two weeks** = 483 years
- d. **a decree** = Artaxerxes, king of Persia, gave Nehemiah the decree to rebuild Jerusalem
- e. 14th of March in 445 B.C to 6th of April 32 A.D. = 483 years
- f. Jesus' Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem on the 10th of Nisan

VII. **Zechariah's King on a D_____ (Zech. 9:9):**

- a. This King will turn the Gentiles into "**a remnant for our God**"
- b. The donkey symbolized Jesus humble mission to seek and to save the lost—
Luke 19:10; Matt. 18:11

VIII. **John the Baptist's L_____ of God (John 1:29):**

- a. The last Old Testament book of the Bible promised a "messenger" and after 400 years God sent John the Baptist to herald the coming of the King!—Mal. 3:1
